Program Schedule: August 23rd, 2017 through June 8th, 2018 M - F (Follows BASD Calendar and Cancellations).

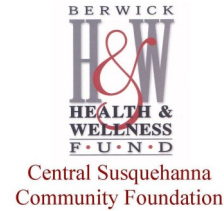

After Care: \$15 per child per week.

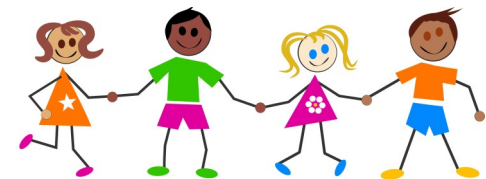
